

### Offering a Warm Welcome

As the cost of living soars and many people are struggling to pay their fuel bills, the Council of Stewards are considering working with other statutory and voluntary organisations in the town (including Churches Together in Dorchester) to open an area of the church building to provide warmth and a welcome. The plans are at a very early stage and will be influenced by government policy and other local provision but if you think that you would be willing to help in some way, please speak to one of the stewards.

### Christmas Shoe Boxes

We will again be filling Christmas shoe boxes for the Foundation for Social Change and Inclusion based at St Paul's Church in Salisbury. The charity works to break the cycle of poverty and marginalisation for some of the most vulnerable individuals and communities in south east Europe. They prevent exploitation and human trafficking, helping to effect positive change throughout the region. UCD collected over 30 shoe boxes last Christmas which went to Bulgaria. Leaflets should be available soon and we hope to have the boxes dedicated in mid-November.

#### Dorset Historic Churches Ride and Stride

Many thanks to all who sponsored Eric Young for this event on 10<sup>th</sup> September. He cycled 35 miles and visited 24 churches. He expects to raise about £300, half of which will go to the Dorset Historic Churches Trust and half to United Church Dorchester.
