Today's readings illustrate the importance of fellowship with other Christians. Let us start by praying for our friends and asking god to forgive us for when we have neglected them. Take time to name them before God.

CONFESSION.

Heavenly Father, I have often neglected family and friends (take time to name some before god) and just gone my own way, I ask your forgiveness and that of those I have hurt and ask you to show me a better way of life. Amen.

Reading St. John ch.13 v 31 -35

Jesus and his disciples were together for the most sacred meal of the year in the Jewish calendar. They all wanted Jesus to take action against the Jewish authorities who were threatening him. They could not imagine life without him, but they did not know what to do. Judas decided to take action and so he went out to try and force Jesus's hand to take godly action against those who were threatening him. So he missed those last precious hours with Jesus.

I wonder what those other disciples were feeling?
What do we do when one of our group leaves us? Do we try to win them back? Are we sure that we are going the right way? A time for real prayer and seeking the will of God.

Reading Acts 11 v 1-18

Further evidence of God expecting corporate not solo action. Caesarea sent a team to Peter at Joppa, then a team went with Peter from Joppa to Caesarea. Later Peter went to Jerusalem and reported all that had happened. Did any of those involved realise what a momentous change was taking place and that it would open the way for the conversion of the Gentiles and the establishment of the Christian Church.

What does God feel now as He looks at all the divisions in the church? Some groups refusing fellowship and sacraments to other groups. Others offering sacraments to some who have no Christian commitment or faith and who normally never meet in fellowship with Christians. Some denominations have introduced rules for which there is no basis in scripture and set them above what we read in scripture. To what extent should the contents of worship be governed by the personal likes of a few without regard for the feelings and beliefs of others.

What steps for the growth of the church is God asking us to take?

Take an open time of prayer seeking God's will for united action for the growth of Christianity.
