Lord's Prayer

Readings: Jeremiah 20: 7-13 O Lord, you have enticed me, and I was enticed; you have overpowered me and you have prevailed. I have become a laughing-stock all day long; everyone mocks me.

For whenever I speak, I must cry out, I must shout, 'Violence and destruction!' For the word of the Lord has become for me a reproach and derision all day long.

If I say, 'I will not mention him, or speak any more in his name', then within me there is something like a burning fire shut up in my bones;

I am weary with holding it in, and I cannot.

For I hear many whispering: 'Terror is all around! Denounce him! Let us denounce him!' All my close friends are watching for me to stumble.

'Perhaps he can be enticed, and we can prevail against him, and take our revenge on him.' But the LORD is with me like a dread warrior; therefore my persecutors will stumble, and they will not prevail. They will be greatly shamed, for they will not succeed. Their eternal dishonour will never be forgotten.

O LORD of hosts, you test the righteous, you see the heart and the mind;

let me see your retribution upon them, for to you I have committed my cause.

Sing to the LORD; praise the LORD!

For he has delivered the life of the needy from the hands of evildoers.

<u>Matthew 10: 24-39</u> A disciple is not above the teacher, nor a slave above the master; it is enough for the disciple to be like the teacher, and the slave like the master. If they have called the master of the house Beelzebul, how much more will they malign those of his household! 'So have no fear of them; for nothing is covered up that will not be uncovered, and nothing secret that will not become known. What I say to you in the dark, tell in the light; and what you hear whispered, proclaim from the housetops. Do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell. Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground unperceived by your Father. And even the hairs of your head are all counted. So do not be afraid; you are of more value than many sparrows. 'Everyone therefore who acknowledges me before others, I also will acknowledge before my Father in heaven; but whoever denies me before others, I also will deny before my Father in heaven.

'Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth; I have not come to bring peace, but a sword. For I have come to set a man against his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law; and one's foes will be members of one's own household. Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me; and whoever does not take up the cross and follow me is not worthy of me. Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it.

Reflection What are the first images that come to mind when you hear the word 'success'? Achievement, recognition, a following, financial security, a few more goals in the

back of the net!!? If we go with this kind of definition, then by all accounts, Jeremiah was not a successful person. And yet, in God's eyes, he was a most successful prophet. It was Jeremiah's obedience and faithfulness to the task God had set for him that made him successful. Jeremiah was called to take a message to the nation of Israel and the leaders of Judah to return to God in repentance, otherwise there would be dire consequences for them at the hand of their enemies.

As you can imagine, Jeremiah was not a popular person and he suffered all kinds of abuses at the hands of those who did not want to hear his message. However, Jeremiah was faithful and despite all the difficulties, he found the capacity to praise God, and he did what God asked him to do. The knowledge that God was with him, gave him the perseverance, strength and courage to do it

The passage in Matthew's gospel also highlights the challenges and difficulties which are to be expected when following Jesus. There is an exhortation to persevere because, in the end, God will reveal the true nature of everyone's actions. Those who oppose God will eventually be exposed for what they really are and those who are true to God will be acknowledged as such. One day, everything will be out in the open.

These passages put the spotlight on our understanding of mission today. How do we share God's message of love with others? Does the gospel message burn like fire within us, as did God's words within Jeremiah? When he tried to have an easier time by saying nothing, he discovered it was impossible to even try to keep the message to himself. Jeremiah's body protested until he spoke Gods' message to the people to repent and turn back to God. (v9) Does God's message stir us up so much inside that no matter how hard we try to push it away or keep it in, or what obstacles are before us, in the end God's word must be spoken and lived?

Matthew's gospel, highlights Jesus' warning to his disciples of the power of God's message but also the powers that would try to oppose it; the conflict God's message would stir up – especially within families. Matthew had a clear idea of what it cost to be a disciple – in pure monetary terms, there was no going back for someone who gave up being a tax collector for the Romans. But Matthew is also keen to point out the rewards of faithfulness to Jesus' great commission – the promise of acknowledgement by God for what the disciples had done.

So what of us? The last few words of this passage in Matthew's gospel gives us our direction. Put God First! The stakes are high, the calling is tough. Each of us has our cross to carry. How can we succeed if God is not first in everything, guiding and directing everything that we think, speak or do? And that is when God's wonderful promise is there to uphold us. We cannot rely on our own resources to do God's work. It is only possible when we rely on his strength, through his Holy Spirit within us.

Our steps of faith might be small but we must take them and they will lead to a world which is hungry for satisfaction which only comes from God. Steps of faith always involve risk and that's uncomfortable and scary. Jeremiah knew it, the disciples knew it, Jesus himself knew it. But God says to us, do not be afraid, I am with you. If you do what I ask, the rewards are everlasting. Amen
